Shri Swami Vivekanand Shikshan Sanstha, Kolhapur established in June 1954 by Late Shikshan Maharshi Dr. Bapuji Salunkhe has been working in the field of education with its more than 370 centers across the Maharashtra and Karnataka states.

Vivekanand college, Kolhapur is one of the major centres of the sanstha, established in the sacred and historical city of Kolhapur in June 1964, the centenary year of Swami Vivekanand. Thus the college remains a permanent monument of Swami Vivekanand.

GENERAL RULES

- 1) Admissions are given as per State Govt. and University rules.
- 2) Repeaters are not admitted.
- 3) Marathi Medium for Arts faculty.
- 4) Marathi and English Medium for Commerce faculty.
- 5) English Medium for Science faculty.
- 6) Students requiring Transfer Certificates should apply in prescribed form and pay T.C. fee in the college office.
- 7) It is mandatory for all students to attend all lectures, practicals , tests, tutorials and examinations. Those who will not attend and show satisfactory performance shall lose the right for the admission for the next year. They will be penalized for the same.
- 8) Annual Social Gathering will not be held.
- 9) The college enforces a dress code of Salwar-Kameez - Dupatta for all girl students. Sleeveless is not allowed
- 10) Use of Mobile Phone in College Campus and Classrooms is strictly prohibited.
- 11) The Government of Maharashtra has banned the ragging and notified ragging as a cognizable offence. It is operative in the college premises and hostel.
- 12) Students' four wheelers are forbidden in the college premises.



- 13) Parking rules for two wheelers are mandatory.
- 14) Change in subjects will not be allowed after 31 st of August.
- 15) The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding in all matters.
- 16) Principal reserves the right to amend/modify rules.
- 17) The college provides hostel facility for girl students. The girl students seeking admission in the college hostel should apply to the Principal in a prescribed form which can be had from the college office.

RULES FOR ADMISSION

- 1) The Principal reserves the right of admission.
- 2) The students seeking admission should submit the following documents with the application form.
 - i) School Leaving Certificate and Original Mark-Sheet of last examination passed along with two attested Xerox copies thereof by the competent authority.
 - ii) Eligibility Certificate (Provisional / Final) in original from M.S.B.S. & H. S. E. Or Shivaji University, Kolhapur. (Only for students migrating from other states or Universities)
- 3) All admissions are valid only for one academic year subject to the satisfactory attendance and performances in Test, Terminal and Preliminary Examinations.
- 4) Students belonging to S.C./S.T./VJ./N.T./O.B.C./S.B.C./wards of Ex-servicemen and physically handicapped should submit two attested Xerox copies of their caste certificate and or the certificate which shall show the proof of the category. These students will be admitted as per the rules of Shivaji University, Kolhapur and Govt. Of Maharashtra.

FEE CONCESSION

- 1) Students belonging to S.C./S.T./V.J./N.T./wards of Ex-servicemen/P.T.C./M.T.C./F.F./ and E.B.C. should submit the necessary documents at the time of admission for securing fee concession.

B) Govt. of India Scholarship:

The students applying for G.O.I, scholarship should submit the scholarship form duly filled in along with the following documents.

 - iii) Ration Card (Two attested Xerox copies)
 - iv) Income Certificate original (One attested Xerox copy) (Income above Rs. One lakh for N.T. S.B.C., O.B.C. and income above Rs. Two lakh for S.T. and S.C. students.)
- 2) The students seeking concession in fees granted to economically backward class (E.B.C.) with annual income of less than Rs. 1,00,000/- must furnish income certificate of parents or guardian issued by the competent authority.

REFUND OF FEES AND DEPOSITS

- 1) Only tuition fee and no other fees shall be refundable.
- 2) Tuition fees are refundable as under:
 - a) The entire amount paid by the student after deducting the 25% as administrative charges subject to following.
 - i) If a student gets his/her admission cancelled before the commencement of the academic term.
 - ii) If a student gets his/her admission to another college or institution having courses which are different from those in this college to which he/she had first sought admission and paid tuition fee provided that he / she has informed the principal of this college well in time (three weeks after the commencement of the academic year) about his/her application for admission to the another institution.

The application for refund in such cases must be forwarded through the head of the institution where the student actually Joins, giving details of such course selected by him/her and the date of his/her application to the concerned institution.



- b) 50% of the amount paid by a student as tuition fee, if he / she applies for cancellation of his / her admission and the refund of fee before the last date of admission to the institution fixed by the university.
 - c) A student shall not be entitled to claim refund of tuition fee if he / she leaves the college after the last date of admission.
 - d) In case of a student who fails to inform the Principal of the college about his / her intension to leave or change the college, full fees for the term or the year, as the case will be charged.
- 3) The amount of caution money, Library deposit, Laboratory deposit etc. shall be refundable with deductions as necessary on account of any damage to the property of the institution such as breakages to laboratory equipments, loss of library books etc. for which a student may be responsible.
 - 4) The applications for refund of such deposit shall be made within six months either from the date he /she leaves the college or completes the course and the college shall refund the amount within 30 days from the date of receipt of application. The student must submit the receipt of fees paid to claim refund of deposits.

DISCIPLINE:

All the students must observe rules and regulations of the college. Students shall not do anything inside or outside the college that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image.

No outside influence, political or any other should be brought to the college directly or indirectly.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Students should always put their Valid College Identity Card around the neck before they enter the college campus. During the conduct of lectures students should not loiter in and around the college premises. While representing the college at any other place the students' behaviour should not be detrimental and injurious to the image of the college.

In case of any problem concerned with the college, students should contact the Principal or the Registrar of the college.

ATTENDANCE

- i) The minimum attendance of 75% of the students for theory, practical and tutorials is compulsory, filling which their terms will not be granted and will not be allowed to appear for the Annual Examination.
- ii) The student who fails to maintain the minimum attendance on account of illness, or any other reason which is deemed fit by the Principal should apply in writing to the Principal for leave of absence, prior or within two days from the date of commencement of such leave, filling which he/she will be treated as defaulter.
- iii) All applications for leave of absence along with medical certificate should be submitted to the college office.

Internet facility for students is being provided in the college Library at the rate of Rs. 5/- per hour. Library is Wi-Fi for laptop internet users.

- 2) Students who have passed H.S.C. (XII Std.) examination conducted by any other statutory Board in India are eligible for admission to F.Y.B.A. / B. Sc. / B.Com class provided they produce provisional and eligibility certificate obtained from Shivaji University, Kolhapur. However final eligibility and migration certificates from previous Board attended should be submitted to the college before the end of the first term.

बी.ए., बी.कॉम. व बी.एस्सी. या पारंपारिक डीग्रीपेक्षा ‘B.Voc.’ हा डीग्री अभ्यासक्रम वेगळा व व्यवसायाभिमूख असा आहे. ही डिग्री मिळविणाऱ्यास इंडस्ट्रीमध्ये नोकरी मिळण्याची शक्यता खूप वाढते. कारण ही डिग्री मिळवण्यासाठी प्रत्यक्ष काम करावे लागणार आहे. त्यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांनी या पर्यायाचा जाणिवपूर्वक विचार करावा. जून २०१४ पासून आपल्या महाविद्यात खालील दोन विषयांसाठी B.Voc. हा डीग्री अभ्यासक्रम विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोगाच्या (UGC) च्या अनुदानातून सुरू झाले आहे. या अभ्यासक्रमास शिवाजी विद्यापीठाची मान्यता आहे व सर्टिफिकेट शिवाजी विद्यापीठ देणार आहे.

UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009

Objectives :

To root out ragging in all its forms from universities, colleges and other educational institutions in the country by prohibiting it by law, preventing its occurrence by following the provisions of these regulation punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and appropriate law in force.

Definition of Ragging :

"Ragging" Means :

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course & which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging:

Abetment to Ragging, criminal conspiracy to rag, unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging, public nuisance created during ragging, violation of decency and morals through ragging. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, use of criminal force, assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences, extortion, criminal trespass, offences against property, criminal intimidation, attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s), physical or psychological humiliation, all other offences from the definition of "Ragging"
